Dear Dr. Brenner:

After review of the requested interim report, the continuing accreditation status of the certificate radiography program sponsored by The Valley Hospital - Paramus Campus was considered at the December 8, 2025 meeting of the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT). The JRCERT is the only agency recognized by the United States Department of Education (USDE) and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) for the accreditation of traditional and distance delivery educational programs in radiography, radiation therapy, magnetic resonance, and medical dosimetry. Specialized accreditation awarded by the JRCERT offers institutions significant value by providing peer evaluation and by assuring the public of quality professional education in the radiologic sciences. The program was evaluated according to the **Standards for an Accredited Educational Program in Radiography (2021)**. The program documents compliance with all relevant Standards; therefore, the JRCERT awards:

**MAINTENANCE OF ACCREDITATION FOR A PERIOD OF EIGHT YEARS.**

The next site visit is tentatively scheduled for the Third Quarter of 2029.

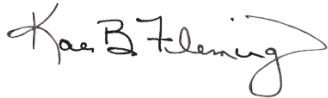
The program is advised that magnetic resonance (MR) safety policies should reflect that students are mandated to notify the program should their status change. The program is also advised to update its clinical supervision policies to include that students must be directly supervised during surgical and all mobile procedures, including mobile fluoroscopy, regardless of the level of competency. These advisements will be further evaluated at the time of the next program review (e.g., continuing application/self-study report and site visit).

Lastly, the program is advised that consistent with JRCERT Policy 11.600, the JRCERT reserves the right to conduct unannounced site visits of accredited programs. The sponsoring institution would be responsible for the expenses of any onsite evaluation.

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The Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology Directors and staff congratulate you and the program faculty for maintaining the maximum award of accreditation from the JRCERT and wish you continued success in your efforts to provide a quality educational program.
