No fee; voluntary donations are accepted. Requirements: Elderly, age 60 plus, permanently or temporarily disabled or income eligible – economically disadvantaged. Residents or veterans. Telephone reservations at least five days in advance. Provides specialized curb to curb transportation, Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 am and 5:30 pm to medical, mental health, dental, doctors, hospitals and clinic appointments, nutrition sites, employment, educational sites, recreation and shopping activities. Evening and Saturday transportation is available by appointment.

Montville Dial – A – Ride (973) 331-3336

The dial-a-ride program is coordinated out of the Health Office. Two drivers provide transportation services to senior citizens of Montville and Boonton Townships in a mid-sized bus with wheelchair lift or a passenger vehicle as appropriate. Rides are provided to doctor, dental and therapy appointments, nutritional sites, shopping and other activities. Montville Township works cooperatively with the Morris Area Paratransit System (MAPS) to secure rides for senior citizens when the municipal vehicles are over booked.

Morris County Paratransit (MAPS) (973) 366-9378

MAPS is a special transportation service in Morris County for senior citizens and persons with disabilities. MAPS uses small busses, vans and station wagons to provide transportation to medical facilities, education or employment sites, adult day care and other locations. Many MAPS vehicles are specially equipped for persons who use wheelchairs. You can use MAPS if you are age 60 or older or you have a physical or mental disability that includes functional limitations. Chemotherapy, radiation therapy and dialysis will be the highest priority

For regular daytime MAPS trips you must call the provider for your region at least 48 hours in advance. For evening or weekend trips you must call at least two weeks in advance. Only a limited amount of evening and weekend service is available. Contact Sophie Dyer (973) 627-7033 to make weekend and evening arrangements.

The following is a suggested donation scale. You may give more or less. You cannot be refused service if you can not make a donation.

For evening and weekend service:

\$2.00 per round trip for travel within Morris County

\$3.00 per round trip for travel outside Morris County

For transportation to sheltered workshops:

\$0.50 per round trip or \$10.00 per month.

For transportation to other employment:

\$1.00 per round trip or \$20.00 per month (if your income is less than \$30,000 per year)

\$2.00 per round trip or \$40.00 per month (if your income is more than \$30,000 per year)

For all other trips:

\$1.00 per round trip.
